General Information

Purpose

The Belle Valley Parents' Booster Club is a self-supporting organization that is non-profit, non-sectarian and non-partisan. **Its purpose is to supply the schools with materials and resources not supplied with regular school funds such as supplemental books, character education materials and funding for field trips.** The Booster Club also provides additional funds to support educational, yet entertaining, activities for students that enhance the school district curriculum and state standards. To raise money, fundraisers are held throughout the year that not only raise necessary funds but promote partnerships with families and community members. The Booster Club also promotes cooperation with the teachers without interference with regular school programs, laws or policies.

Membership Fees

The Booster Club requires \$2 per year per family to become a voting member. The payment can be made during registration, sent in with an envelope provided anytime during the school year or paid at a monthly meeting. This money helps the Booster Club launch its activities at the beginning of the school year.

Meetings

Booster Club meetings are held on the second Tuesday of every month at Belle Valley North in the gym. The meetings begin at 7 p.m. and last approximately one hour. Please join us... All ideas to help support our schools are welcome.

Special School Services, Events and Fundraisers

Purchasing

The Booster Club's officers are in charge of overseeing the purchase of approved items requested by the faculty and the Booster Club. These purchase requests will be brought to the meetings for approval.

School Pictures

School pictures are taken in the fall and the spring. These photos are available for purchase and will be the pictures used in the school yearbook.

School Yearbook

The yearbook committee formulates and distributes the yearbook. Pictures taken of students and staff at various school functions are accepted by the committee throughout the year.

School Carnival

Our annual school carnival will be held May 14 at Belle Valley South from 1 to 7 p.m. Students are dismissed early on this day. Chairpersons are needed for each activity, such as food, games, rides, publicity, etc. If you don't have a lot of time to give, we always need volunteers who can work for one hour. We always look forward to this fun and exciting day of rides, games, prizes and food.

Speakers and Guests

Throughout the year, the Booster Club works with several school committees to bring a wide array of special events and presentations that promote student learning and character education. Many of these events are cost-prohibitive and would not be possible without Booster Club support.

Staff Appreciation

The staff/teacher appreciation event takes place in May, honoring our school staff with a delicious brunch and gifts.

Holiday Events

In the past, the Booster Club has sponsored a variety of holiday events including the fall festival, visits from Santa and a gift shop for students. We look forward to planning similar events this year.

Skating Parties

The Booster Club and Fun Spot will host six skating parties this year: Aug. 21, Sept. 25, Oct. 23, Feb. 26, March 19 and April 23. The "welcome back party" on Aug. 21 will have free admission with a \$2/\$4 skate rental. All other parties will have a \$3 admission with skate rental available for \$2/\$4. The parties are 5 to 7 p.m. and are for all students at both schools.

Papa John's Pizza Night

Every second Thursday of the month throughout the school year, Papa John's Pizza will be hosting a fundraiser for the Booster Club. The Booster Club gets a percentage of the cost of all pizzas ordered by Belle Valley families. The classroom in each school that has the greatest participation will receive a class pizza party.

Shopping Cards

The Booster Club also receives funding from Schnuck's and the Belleville Farmer's Market through their eScrip and Farmer's 4 Education programs, respectively. While shopping, present the store's card at check-out and a percentage of the purchase will be donated to the schools through the Booster Club.
