

Booster Club Meeting – October 13th, 2009

1. Call to Order – 7:07pm
2. Additions to Agenda – None
3. Approval of Minutes – Motion to approve the minutes was passed.
4. Introductions and Review – Jason Warner made introduction for the new parents.
5. Officer Reports
 - 5.1 President Jason Warner addressed changes to the By-Laws and changing the name to Parent Teacher Organization. This will be tabled until next month. Membership drive brought in about \$150. We are at \$250 in membership fees. This includes the money from registration and money from the September newsletter. Fun Spot had a good turnout for September. 200 cans were donated to the Faith Baptist Food Pantry. We are doing the can donations again for the Oct. 23 date.
 - 5.2 Treasurer Steve Monterusso reported that the beginning balance was \$20,568.13 with expenses of \$174.10. An ending balance of \$20,438. Finding a date for a pizza fundraising should be soon because the dates are filling up quick for the company.
 - 5.3 Secretary Sharon Radecki has nothing to report.
 - 5.4 North Principal Kathy Goetter wrote a report that was read by Jason Warner. McTeacher Night brought in \$673. Red Cross conducted a Mini Workshop on proper hygiene and hand washing. East Side Fire Dept. is coming Oct. 16 for fire safety. RIF (Reading is Fundamental) is celebrated on Oct. 16 with a school wide book distributions. End of first quarter is Oct. 16 and Report Cards go home Oct. 23. Also a reminder that Parent/Teacher conferences are from 1 to 8 p.m. on Oct. 29 and Teacher Institute on Oct. 30.
 - 5.5 South Principal Tammy Leib suggested that we use the Parent/Teacher Conferences to hand out the Schnucks card. The month of October at South offers a Chorus event along with volleyball beginning and an 8th grade field trip to Springfield. The 8th grade teacher received a \$500 grant and chaperone a dance to help offset some of the cost. The schools fundraiser had about \$20,000 in sales with about 40 to 45 percent profit. Great job everybody. We also discussed getting vinyl stickers to use for prizes and sales. Dr. Leib is working on getting the design chosen.
6. Purchasing Requests - Note: \$1163.31 was used for the teachers at Teachers Aid Store.
 - 6.1 Kathy Goetter made a request for \$2500 to help with field trip buses. This item was called to motion, seconded, and approved.
 - 6.2 Tammy Leib made a request for \$3400 to help with field trip buses. This item was called to motion, seconded, and approved.
 - 6.3 Assembly committee made a request for \$1740 to the African Acrobats and Storyteller Bobby Norfolk. This item was called to motion, seconded, and approved.
 - 6.4 Asst. Principal Trenese Dancy made a request for \$1500 for Character Education Program. After a discussion, a motion for \$1000 was made, second, and approved. (The remaining \$500 will be addressed at a later date depending on Booster Club funds.)
 - 6.5 Traci Horton requests \$559.92 for Leap Pads. This item was called to motion, seconded, and approved.
7. Committees
 - 7.1 Trunk or Treat is to be held Oct. 28, 6 to 8 p.m. This item was called to motion, seconded, and approved. A costume contest will be held with three winners from each grade level (Pre-K to 6th). Sharon, Jason and one other will be the judges. Note: Steve may be busy with the food. Sharon will get the prizes for the 24 winners. Steve will be handling all the food and drink items. Hot chocolate and cups are being provided by Andrea Kunz. Kristy Turner will

do the fliers and possibly the certificates for the winners.

7.2 Santa Kottage will be Dec. 9 to 11 and Tribout's as the supplier. This item was called to motion, seconded, and approved. A chairperson will be chosen next month.

7.3 Carnival for May 14 from 1:30 to 7 p.m. Tribout's will supply the rides and inside carnival items. This item was called to motion, seconded, and approved. Armbands will be around \$10 and single tickets will be sold also. Chairperson will be chosen at a later date.

7.4 Golf Tournament – no motion at this time. Steve is working on getting things going for this. An October date is what was discussed.

8. Open Forum – Karen Gros has brought a fundraiser idea to the table. Soc Box is a photo card printing company. For \$49 you would get the intro box and a key to start the order process online. Of the \$49 dollars, the Boosters would receive \$20. We also discussed if the Booster received any addition moneys after the initial purchase, maybe for a set amount of time.
